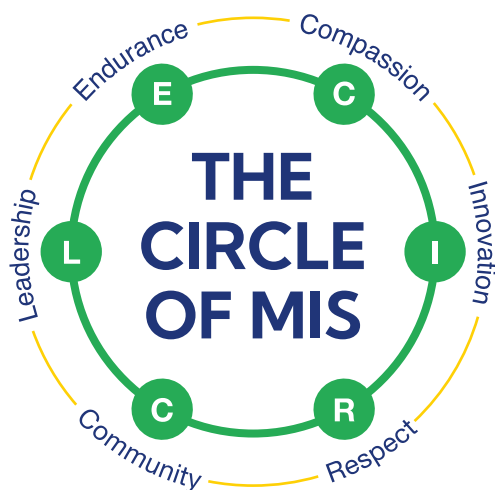

Preschool A&B – Kindergarten

AGES 2-4

Learning through doing: creative play, exploration and sensory discovery lay the foundations for a lifelong love of learning.



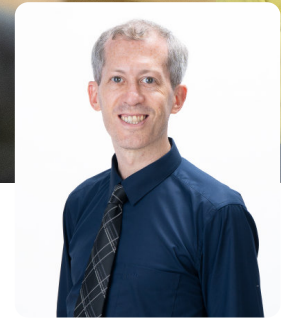
Communication Development

KEY STAGE 1 PRIMARY SCHOOL

Year 1 – Year 2

AGES 5-7

In Key Stage 1, students begin building essential foundations in literacy and numeracy within a supportive and engaging learning environment. Guided by the English National Curriculum and enriched with certified standardised resources, learning is hands-on, interactive and designed to spark curiosity. At this stage, the focus is on developing confidence across a broad range of skills, encouraging collaboration and creating meaningful learning experiences that motivate and excite young learners.



KEY STAGE 2 PRIMARY SCHOOL

Year 3 – Year 6

AGES 7-11

In Key Stage 2, students build on their early foundations with a greater emphasis on academic development and independent thinking. Learning at this stage becomes more structured, allowing students to deepen their understanding across subjects. Beyond knowledge acquisition, students develop transferable skills, critical thinking and adaptability, preparing them for the challenges of a rapidly evolving world and laying the groundwork for future academic success in the Secondary School and beyond.

KEY STAGE 3 SECONDARY SCHOOL

PREP YEARS | Year 7 – Year 9

AGES 11-14

This is where students begin to discover their strengths and build the confidence to take ownership of their learning. As students transition into their teenage years, MIS provides the structure and support they need to grow into independent, capable learners. With subject-specialist teachers and the English National Curriculum, students begin to deepen their knowledge while developing critical thinking skills.



KEY STAGE 4 SECONDARY SCHOOL

IGCSEs | Year 10 – Year 11

AGES 14-16

In Years 10 and 11, students begin the IGCSE journey—an internationally respected qualification that opens doors to future academic opportunities worldwide. At this stage, learning becomes more focused, purposeful and aligned with each student's strengths.

Here, students gain the discipline and results that set the direction for their future.



KEY STAGE 5 SECONDARY SCHOOL

SIXTH FORM | Year 12 – Year 13

AGES 16-18

In Sixth Form, students specialise in a small number of subjects through A-Level, allowing them to study in-depth and prepare for university with purpose. This stage is designed to develop independence, leadership, initiative and academic excellence.

This is where students turn ambition into direction and preparation into real-world outcomes.
